I wish to therefore appeal to ask again the same question as I am unable to find the answer namely: **"Could you advise the Aerotoxic Association how airline passengers are protected from fume events whilst flying on board "bleed air" system jet aircraft."**

I am aware that passengers have inflatable life jackets to cater for the possibility of requiring life support in water – what practical protection is provided for passengers when bad smells or a 'fume event' occurs?
