I wish to appeal against your refusal of 21st January 2010 to publish the House of Lords 2007 Science and Technology Committee recommendation 'to identify the substances produced during a fume event be completed urgently'.

It is argued that this information is 'Unfair and not in the airline staff / crews or the Public's interest' – it would be helpful to receive evidence of this unexpected fact – especially when linked to probable serious ill health in minors, who lack a voice.
