Thank you for your letter dated 25th October, which referenced my own letter to Dr Michaelis dated 23rd August on the subject of aircraft cabin air quality.

My letter to Dr Michaelis set out the Company's considered response to each of the points made by Dr Michaelis and I believe that the points made apply equally to the issues raised in your letter.

The Company will continue to rely upon guidance from official safety agencies and scientific experts, based on independent studies and evidence reviews. We fully support the European Aviation Safety Agency's call for a further study to be undertaken and will carefully consider the published findings of any such study.

I am sure that you will appreciate that far from being intransigent, the Company remains absolutely open and willing to consider the views of scientific experts based upon independent research.

I thank you for your kind offer of tea in the House of Lords but I am afraid that unless and until the body of expert scientific opinion on this subject changes, no useful purpose would be served by such a meeting.
